
On June 16, 2006, Lead Counsel for the class in the WorldCom Securities Litigation requested permission for the Administrator to allow late claims by class members so long as they were filed by June 15, 2006. The Administrator represents that this extension will not delay the processing of claims, and Lead Counsel represents that it will not materially impact the amounts distributed to individual class members. Finding that the extension will permit the receipt of settlement funds by otherwise qualified class members without materially affecting the well-being of class members who filed timely claims, it is hereby

ORDERED that claims by class members for distributions from the settlements in the WorldCom securities class action will be deemed timely if submitted to the Administrator by June 15, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any objection to the extension embodied in this Order must be filed with the Court, and served on Lead Counsel for the class by July 7, 2006.
